Kemmerer Wyoming is looking for a few good teachers. We are currently looking to hire three teachers. We currently have teachers with multiple endorsements; therefore, depending on our need, we can change what teachers are required to teach. We are looking to hire in the following areas:

K-6 P.E. or 7-12 P.E., Potential History, Potential 7-12 English, Potential Business, Potential Art Potential Math, Potential Science, Head boys basketball coach.

The only position that would be exclusively one subject would be science. The other two positions would be a combination. For example, the teacher may teach 4 periods of P.E. and two of history, or three periods of math and three of art or P.E., or four periods of business and two math. Any combination would be considered.

A teacher would not have to be certified in both subject areas; however, they need to be certified in one area with an interest and a propensity in the second area. The teacher hired would need to seek an exceptional authorization over the next three years. The district would pay for the cost of the classes. For interested individuals, the district will give more information on this process on an individual basis.

Kemmerer's base salary is currently \$42,000. The head coaching stipend is approximately \$5,500. The district provides full health and dental for a cost of \$50.00 a month for singles, and \$100.00 a month for family coverage. Full retirement benefit is provided for the employee. The district pays 21% of your salary into a retirement account, and the employee contributes 1% of their salary into the retirement account. Wyoming has no state income tax; therefore, your take home pay is more.


The high school population is approximately 180 students, with a community population of over 3,000. Kemmerer is a rural community located two hours north east of Salt Lake City, which provides a big city atmosphere if one is desired. Kemmerer is at an elevation of 7,000 feet, and Kemmerer is approximately three hours south east of Jackson Hole. Kemmerer is considered high plains, yet it is on the edge of the Wyoming Range. As a result Kemmerer provides some of the nations best mule deer, and elk hunting. The Hamsfork River, which flows

through Kemmerer, has been referenced as one of the nation's best kept secrets in regard to fishing. Kemmerer also has access to great skiing and other outdoor fisheries.
