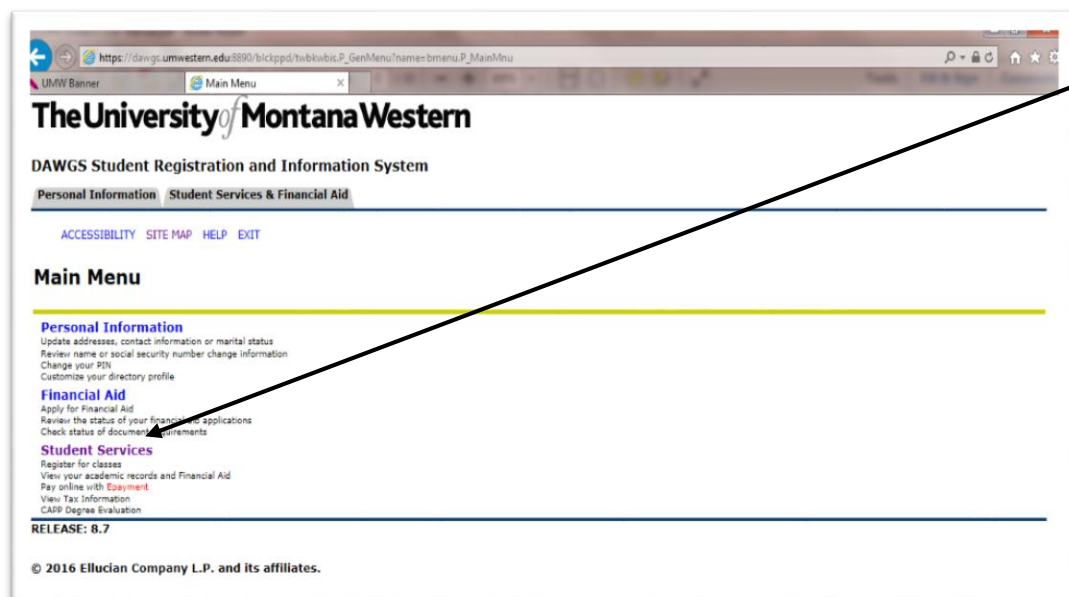
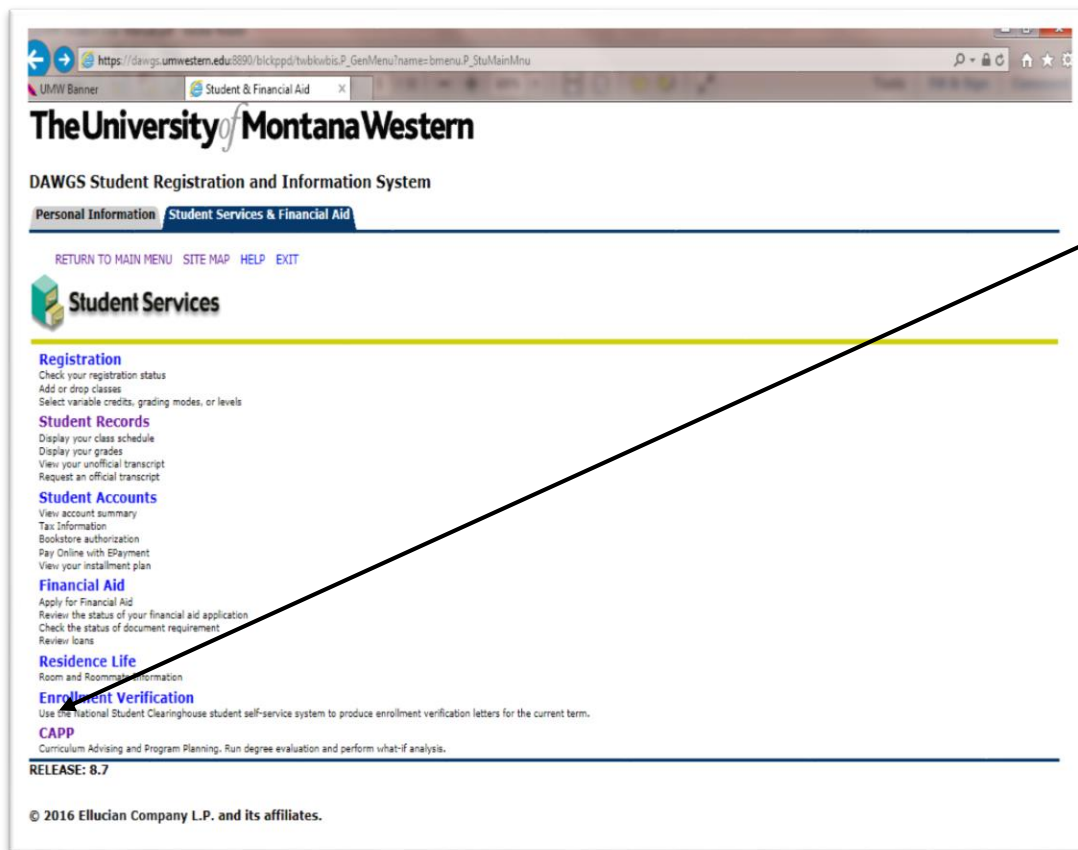


# CAPP Degree Evaluation Student User Manual

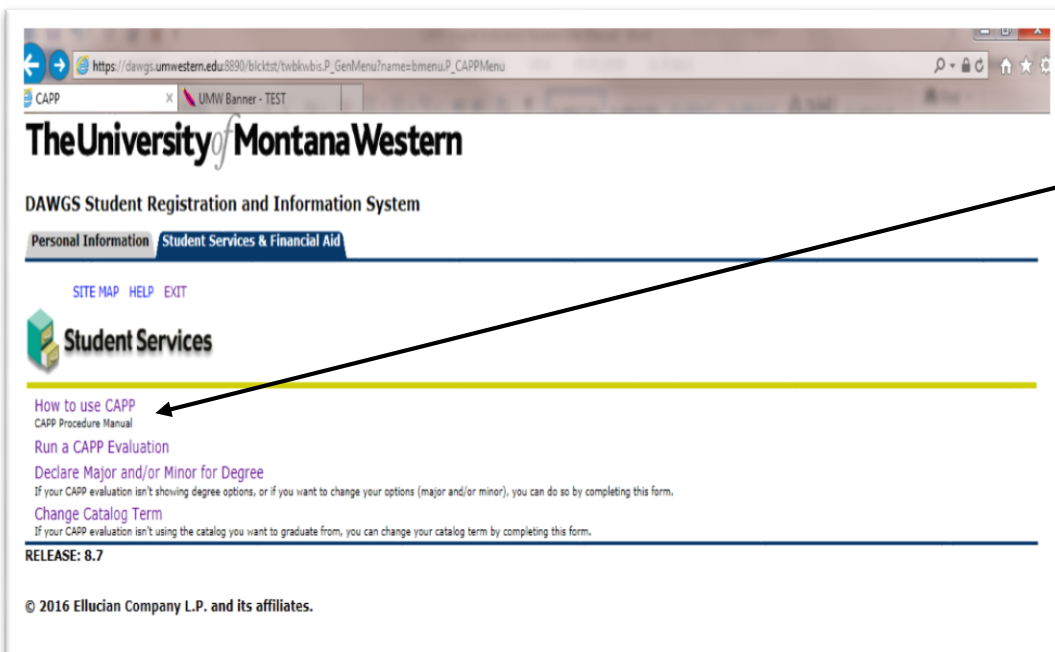
CAPP degree evaluation is a feature available through DAWGS. CAPP stands for Curriculum, Advising, and Program Planning and offer you an easy accessed tool to produce a degree evaluation and determine if you are on track to complete your degree. This program takes all your courses and compares them to the appropriate degree, major, and minor to see how close you are to finishing highlighting what requirements you have completed and are still pending. **Program Description**

The Bachelor of Science in Business Administration requires 120 credits which consist of 31-32 credits of general education; 50 credits of major core and internship; the selection of a 32 credit option area; and 6-7 general electives. Student pursuing this degree must also pass the Computer Literacy Exam (CAPP 191E).

The first thing you'll see is the program requirements. This program requires you to complete 120 credits, of which 30 must be completed through UMW. You must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.00.

Next is the description of the program. This shows how the 120 credits are broken out and any additional requirements for the program

Typically the first areas you will see in an evaluation relates to your major and minor requirements. A summary of the areas is available at the start of each area.

The next section of the area list the detail requirements.

In the first couple of columns, you'll see the courses you are required to complete.

Next, you'll see the courses you have completed to meet that requirement, including the semester you took the course and the grade you earned.

### *In the Source Column:*

H- You have taken the class and CAPP is pulling the information from your academic history

T- You have transferred that class in from another college.

R- You are currently registered in the class.

The General Electives (titled Z-electives) is an area with two purposes. First, almost all degrees require general electives. This is the area that all courses that are counting towards elective requirements will appear.

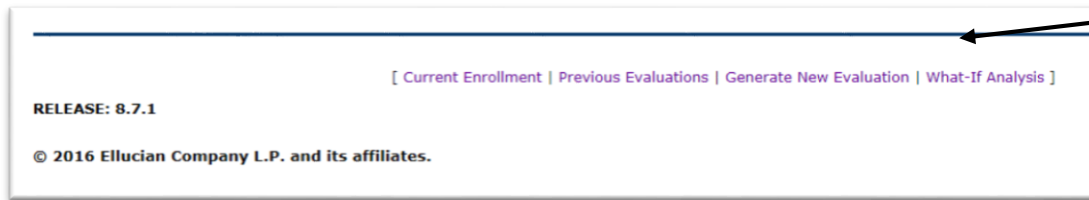
Second, this area is purposely set up to be larger than most programs requirement for electives so that it will catch any course that is passing with a D- or higher and college level, but is not applying to your major, general education, or minor

The excess credits allowed in the electives area helps to make sure that credits taken that do not meeting other requirements are used to help you reach the overall credit goal of the degree.

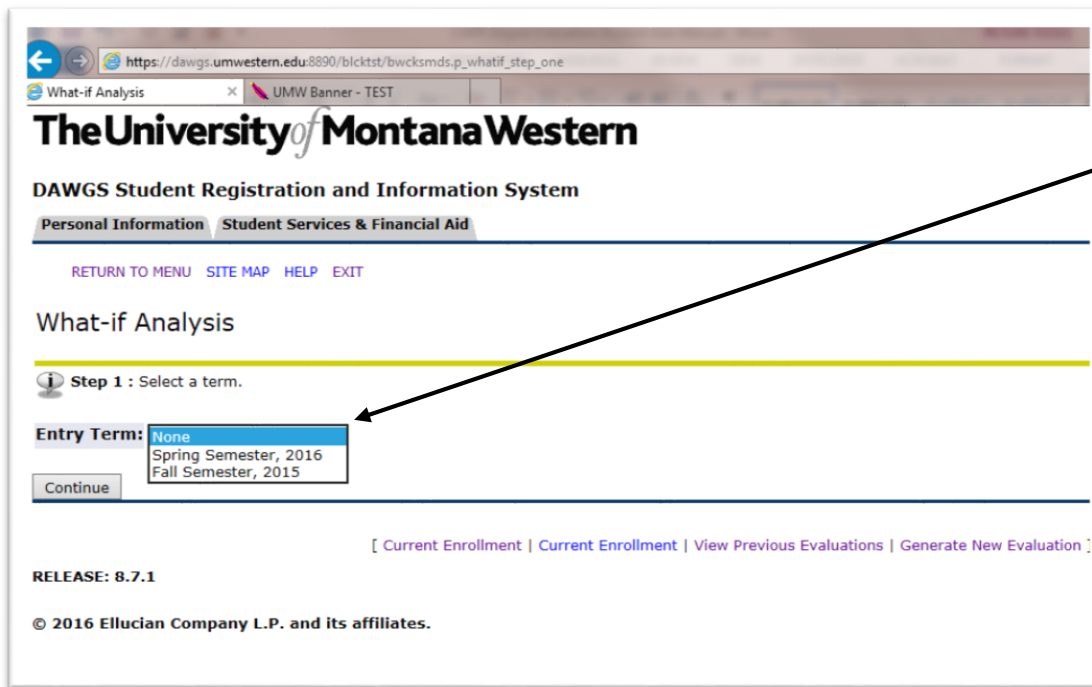
Make sure to check the catalog to make sure you know exactly how many credits you need for electives.

# What-If Analysis

If you are considering changing your major, you can use the What-If Analysis to see which courses of the classes you've already taken can be used to complete the degree requirements of another degree.



To perform a What-If Analysis, click on the link at the bottom of the page.



First choose the catalog year of the degree you are interested in by selecting a term that the degree correlates i.e. a degree from the 2015-16 catalog will be in the Fall 2015 and/or Spring 2016 term. Then select Continue
