How to Apply



Create an account. As part of your profile, set up automatic email notification for status of your application. Create or upload a resume into your account.

Apply Online

Within the vacancy announcment for which you are applying, click "Apply Online." Follow the prompts to complete the questionnaire, to attach documentation, and to submit. You may update your application while the annoucement is open by selecting "update application" under the "application status." Ensure all required documents are current, correctly attached, legible, and within the required timeframe. Read the ENTIRE announcement requirements.

THINGS to Keep in Mind

- ➤ Vacancy announcements in USAJOBS will give examples of specialized experience for each position. Ensure your resume lists your work experience that shows title, series, grade, and time period worked.
- Ensure all required documents are attached to your application. Review them for accuracy and currency. Attach your current IQCS master record.
- Allow adequate time to apply for positions. The process takes time.



Vacancy announcements OPEN in USAJOBS.

SEPT. 29, 2023

Vacancy announcements CLOSE.

Applicants must complete the application process and submit all required documents.

OCT. 3, 2023

Human Resources qualification review period.

Applicants may receive qualification review notices during this time.

NOV. 13, 2023

Hiring managers will begin the hiring process.

NOV. 13-17, 2023 Interviews for positions with a target grade of GS-9. Reference checks for all positions begin. Monitor emails for an automated request to provide references. Notify your current supervisor of reference checks.

NOV 13-DEC 8, 2023 Selections. The majority of selections for positions GS-8 and below are made/offered during the <u>week of Nov. 27-Dec. 8</u>. Selections for lower GS-level positions may extend to the following week.

DEC 8, 2023 - MARCH 2024

Human Resources Management processing. Anticipated effective date to report to duty is March 2024.
