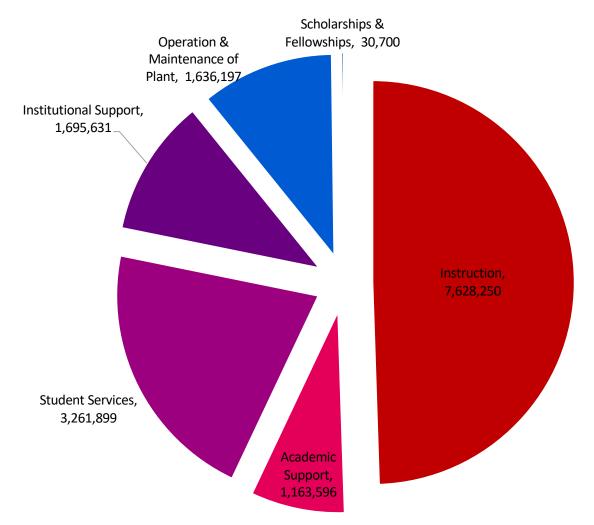

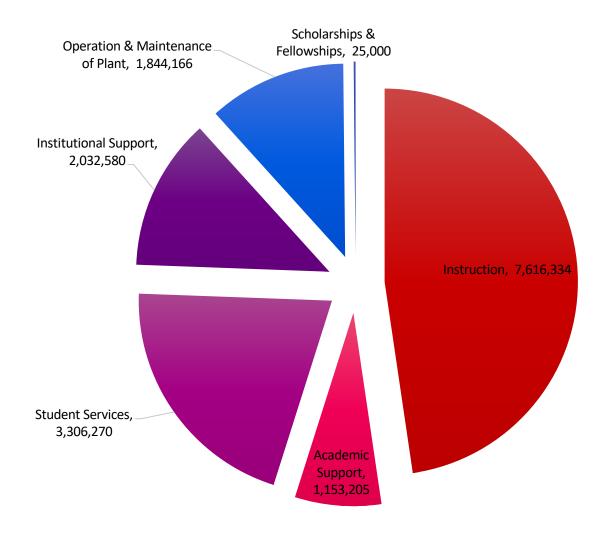

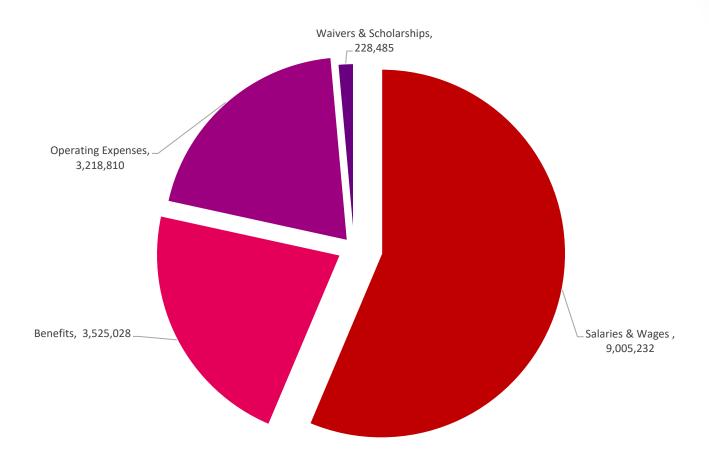

Actual FY23 General Fund Total Operating Expenses \$15.42 M

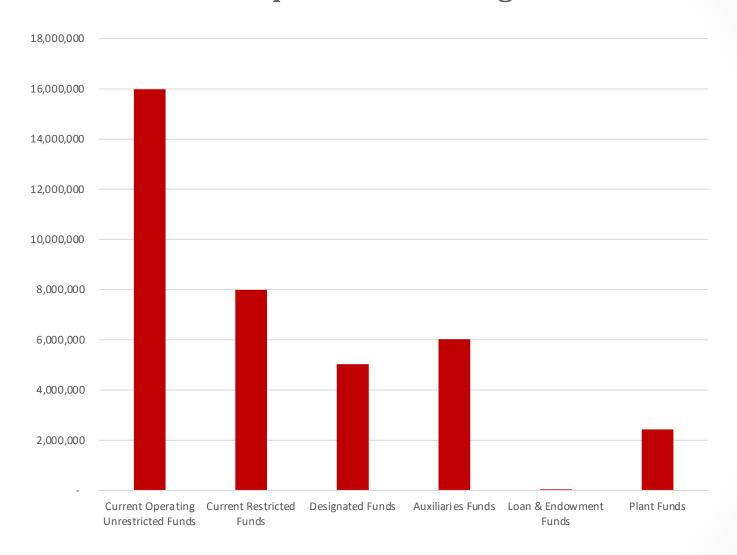


FY24 GENERAL FUND TOTAL OPERATING BUDGET by PROGRAM \$15.98 M

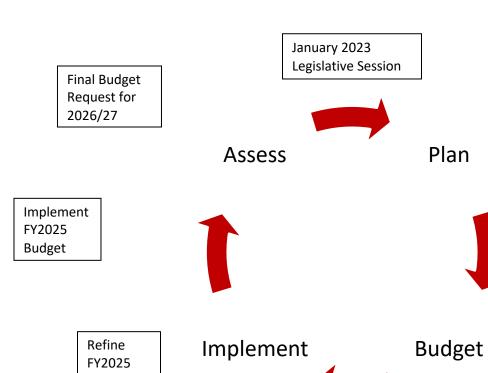


**FY24 General Funds Budgeted Expenditures by Category**
