## **Certificate for Post-Baccalaureate Education Students: Licensure Program**

The post-baccalaureate certificate program consists of seven (7) plans of study (listed below) available to post-baccalaureate students. Once a student successfully completes a selected plan of study, designed for a particular licensure area, UMW awards the post-baccalaureate certificate and makes a licensure recommendation in that area to the Montana Office of Public Instruction. UMW makes licensure recommendations to its post-baccalaureate students only in the areas of study for which it also offers either an education major, an education minor, or both.

- Pre-Kindergarten Grade 3 to K-8 Certificate (for Class 2 license holders with an endorsement in Elementary Education who seek initial licensure in PK 3)
- Early Childhood Education Pre-Kindergarten Grade 3 Certificate (for Teaching & Learning BS degree holders who seek initial licensure in PK 3)
- Physical Education and Health K-12 Certificate
- K-8 to Early Childhood Education Pre-Kindergarten Grade 3 Certificate (for Class 2 license holders with an endorsement in PK 3 who seek initial licensure in K-8)
- Secondary Education Certificate
- Special Education Certificate
