Montana Western to Hold Auditions for "The SpongeBob Musical"



Facility Services Project Updates

Block Hall Renovation Project

Dowling Architects has provided UMW with the completed comprehensive design documents, and construction drawings are currently in development for upcoming contractor bidding. The project maintains its timeline, aiming to release bid documents by October 2023. Pending favorable bids, contractors are anticipated to begin work in April/May 2024.

Wellness Center Project

Engineering design for the project will be finalized by the end of the month. The project is expected to go out for bid sometime in September followed by contracting with a builder sometime in October, with immediate initial site work planned for this fall. Construction is slated for spring/summer 2024, aiming for occupancy by fall 2024.

Sports & Activities Complex

As part of the engineering design process, civil and architectural designs are underway. Civil work and construction documents are nearly finalized, enabling site grading to begin in August. The architectural and mechanical design stands at 75% completion with a groundbreaking ceremony to be held next week. Our goal is to host fall 2024 football games in the new Complex.

Campus Storage Facility Project

The campus storage facility project is underway with civil and architectural planning. The new facility will be built where the current Osborne house is located due to its central campus location. The Osborne house has limited use for significant academic functions and HHP faculty and students, the current users of this space, will temporarily move to the Bridenstein house until the new academic space in Block Hall is completed. Demolition of the Osborne house is planned to take place over the coming weeks, allowing immediate foundation work for the storage building to begin. Construction of the new facility is scheduled for spring 2024.
