Pass Rates by Volume

For the academic year 2020-21, the following pass rates were reported on the ETS *Data Manager Dashboard*, as of 5/12/2021. In this section of the Data Manager, pass rates are reported for the highest volume of test takers (i.e., Elementary Education, in the case of Montana Western), to the lowest volume of test takers (i.e., Library Media Specialists, in the case of Montana Western). Overview: Five Years of Praxis Subject Test Data AY 2015-16 to AY 2019-20

Note: For the exam types listed below, at the top of each table, the **passing score** range is given first, which earns a teacher candidate 3 points on the MACK (Montana Assessment of Content Knowledge) Verification system. The next score range listed is considered "acceptable," which earns a candidate 2 points on the MACK. The third score range is one which earns the candidate only 1 point on the MACK, and is carefully examined by the Licensure Director, to decide whether or not the candidate can be recommended for licensure. (Other elements of the MACK—the candidate's GPA and the Content Knowledge Evaluation From, scored by the mentor teacher—are taken into consideration.) The final score range shown for each table is considered unacceptable, and receives 0 points on the MACK.

EPP Reflections on Results:

- For many of the tests, the pass rates are very good. No concern is expressed
- For mathematics, there is concern with the UMW pass rates, but the N is so small, it is hard to make conclusions about the program, even with five years of data. It was also noted that there is a similar concern at the state level, regarding pass rates for the math Praxis.
- For elementary education, there was considerable concern expressed by the faculty.
- Important note, especially for elementary education: There are a number of re-takes for the elementary education Praxis. The data reveal this quite clearly. Thus, if re-takes were factored out of the data, the "pass rate for elementary education" would actually be higher than what is represented here.
- We now have a number of post-baccalaureate students in the EPP, who are seeking the post-bacc certificate. They are taking everything BUT the elementary education Praxis. (This is because we don't offer a post-bacc certificate in elementary education.) Thus, we have a more mature population of students who are taking the Praxis—a population perhaps more likely to succeed on such a test—in many of these categories, except for elementary education.
- Members of the Early Childhood Education faculty noted that their curriculum is designed with the Praxis more "in mind," than the elementary education program is. Furthermore, the elementary education Praxis is more comprehensive and challenging exam than is the ECE exam.

Decisions/Next Steps:

- The Praxis Working Group (PWG), is addressing concerns regarding the math Praxis. The PWG is a statewide group, composed of representatives from the Montana Office of Public Instruction (OPI) and licensure officers from all of Montana's EPPs, advised by a representative of Educational Testing Service (ETS), which produces the Praxis Subject Assessments. The UMW Director of Student Teaching, Field Experience, and Licensure serves on the PWG.
- Students need to be coached better, regarding their awareness of and preparation for the Praxis exam.
- The above can be accomplished in EDU 201 Introduction to Education with Field Experience, which all EPP students must take.
- Students wait to take the Praxis until after they complete their student teaching; again, coaching to be more proactive, is a good step to address this problem.
- We can/should help students to study and better prepare for the Praxis:
 - Praxis study groups could be organized within the Education Club
 - Work with the UMW library to make sure that Praxis study resources are available
 - Possibility: Use work study students as study group leaders of Praxis study groups. (Thus, the leaders would be compensated for this work.)
